## **Operational notes:**

### **Kick Off Times**

All competition ties **MUST** proceed as scheduled unless **by mutual agreement** both club teams decide otherwise. In the event of change to the listed time **to be notified to the Results Officer** then the **HOME** club must liaise and confirm this with the appointed referee. Where there is disagreement or disputation regarding the kick off time then a tie proceeds **as scheduled by the competition's administrator.**

### **Postponements**

Postponements due to weather must be notified to Roger Fagge 07542 262669 immediately. Games will then be re-scheduled for the following week. Should a ground look unfit for a second time then the Secretary will have the discretion to determine an alternative venue, which may mean the game being transferred to the ground of the home team's scheduled match day opponents.

Final scores to be communicated, by the home side to Chris Nicholson 01482 869636 before 3.30pm however clubs failing to do so by that time **will be fined £20.00 by order of the BARLA Executive Committee**

It is the responsibility of the **HOME** club to contact and liaise directly with the appointed referee prior to the game.

Playing areas must be fully enclosed to prevent the encroachment of spectators on to the field of play (BARLA rule 15.11)

### **Team Selection & Substitutions**

**For the sake of uniformity throughout the competition club teams are allowed to select from seventeen (17) players and may exercise during ties – including Extra Time and the Golden Point should a need arise – the use of unlimited substitutes all of whom MUST be recorded on the Official Team Sheet for retention ahead of the tie by the match day referee.**

### **Player Registration Cards**

Clubs must produce openly for inspection by their match day opposition each participating player's registration card. The failure to produce cards for whatever reason by one of the competing club teams will result in a tie being forfeited is likely to incur a fine. In the event of cards having not been produced then play shall **NOT** proceed. The team defaulting shall be liable for all operational costs to include the full entitlement of the match referee should he/she have travelled.

### **Withdrawal from the Competition**

Clubs are reminded of Operational Rule 22.7 which decrees that any club team withdrawing from the competition for whatever reason will be deemed to having brought the game of rugby league in to disrepute **fined a minimum of £100** and if considered appropriate, face suspension from next season's competition.

### **Permits**

BARLA no longer recognises the loaning from professional clubs of "Permit Players". All participants selected for play and fielded in the competition must be recognised as "amateur" only and registered to the club in the prescribed manner.
